On Monday evenings, Mark comes in to The Limelight and we have a choir session with him.



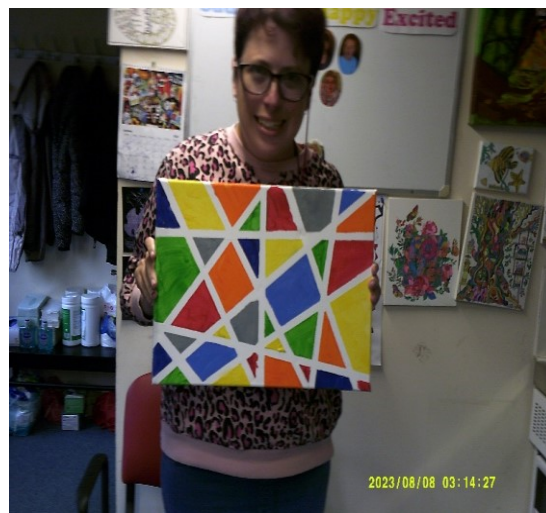


I love Music with Mark, playing all the different instruments he brings in.
